

## Month of Elul

Shofar blown every day except the last day.

Jesus returns to establish Israel and gather the Israelites.

Corresponds to Daniel's 30 days after Tribulation

## 1<sup>st</sup> of Tishri

**Rosh HaShanah-  
Civil New Year-  
Feast of Trumpets**

Jesus is crowned King in Jerusalem and his physical bride Israel with Him. Jesus begins the judgment of Israel

## 1<sup>st</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> of Tishri

**Days of Awe**

This is a time of repentance for Israel as she is being judged

## 10<sup>th</sup> of Tishri

**Yom Kippur-Day of  
Atonement**

The final judgment is rendered and Israel is spared because of the sacrifice of Jesus

## 15<sup>th</sup> of Tishri

**Sukkot-Feast of  
Tabernacles for 7  
days**

Judgment of the nations; battle of Armageddon is waged

## 22<sup>nd</sup> of Tishri

**Special 8<sup>th</sup> day  
Sabbath**

This Sabbath does not fall on a feast day but is a sign of a new age of rest to begin
